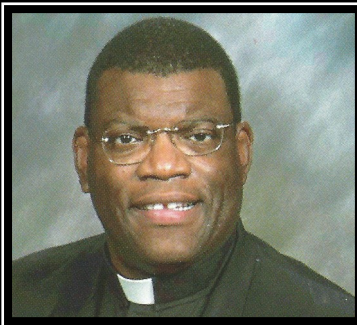

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Trinity Sunday is the Sunday following Pentecost, and eight weeks after Easter Sunday.

In the Catholic Church it is officially known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. Prior to the reforms of the Second Vatican Council. It marked the end of a three week period when church weddings were forbidden.

The doctrine of the Trinity is the Christian belief that: There is one God, who is Father, Son, an Holy Spirit...

Trinity Sunday, which falls on the first Sunday after Pentecost, is one of the few feasts in the Christian calendar that celebrates a doctrine rather than an event.

The liturgical color used on Trinity Sunday is white.



ASSESSMENTS

Perhaps you noticed in the brief financial report that one of our principal checks this week was for Diocesan assessments.

These are four in nature; Cathedraticum, Catholic Virginian, Parish Sharing, and Property and Liability Insurance.

The largest one is the Cathedraticum, which in general assesses all offertory collections and certain designated ones such as collections for flowers, Faith Formation, Parish Beautification, and Fundraising Revenue. However, the bulk of our special collections such as Parish Pence, Uganda, and national causes like Respect for Life are exempt from taxation.

The Diocese employs a slinging scale of percentages based on income which averages about 7% of our total taxable receipts. In successive weeks, we will explain the other assessments. If you have any questions about the Cathedraticum, just contact the office or Ray.

Feast of the Holy Trinity, June 12, 2022

The mystery of the most Holy Trinity is a basic doctrine of Faith in Christianity, understandable not with our heads but with our hearts, not by logic but by faith. It teaches us that there are three distinct Persons in one God, sharing the same Divine Nature, co-equal and co-eternal. Our human mind cannot grasp this doctrine, but we believe in this Mystery because Jesus, who is God, taught it clearly, the Evangelists recorded it, the Church teaches it as central to our Christian Faith.

As Christians, we are baptized 'in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit'. The trinity. So, today as we celebrate the feast of the Holy Trinity, we are not only reminded that we are created in the image of God but that through our Baptism we share in the love and life of God, who is God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. Today we celebrate the most rich inner life of God, in which we are invited to share and take part.

As the Trinity, The Father, The Son, and the Holy Spirit love one another and act/operate in a loving unity. So, we too must always live in love for each other and work as a unity. No one is better than the others. Love is truly the essence of a "Trinity" God. God Created us out of love, and out of love God wants us to know him. But God not only created us, but he chose, and He chooses every day to rescue us when we fail through His Son (God the Son) Jesus. And again, out love he sustains, strengthens, and encourages us in our faith journey through the Holy Spirit.

The three Person of the Trinity: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit are continuously at work within us, they work together for our salvation. Their mutual interactions represent the fullness of love. The Father loves the Son, the Son loves the Father; and the Holy Spirit is the outpouring of their love.

Through our Baptism in the Trinity, we are drawn into this bond of love, and called upon to labor for our own salvation but also the salvation of others. We can only do this if we act and live as people created in the image of the God and marked by the Trinity through our baptism. Our lives should reflect the Trinity in whom we live and move and have our being. It is our life.

The Gospel challenges us to be open to the Spirit of Truth in every aspect of our lives so that the process of being more and more drawn into the divine life of the Trinity may be brought to perfection in us, and in return, we may attract others to God by this divine life we share and live in.

God has a most wonderful plan for each of us, that we reflect the love within the Trinity to the world, that we be the image of God in the world.

As we reflect today on the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity, let each one of us think of the specific plan God has for us, for you. Remember always: You were created in the image of God and from the day you received baptism you share in the love of the Trinity in a special way. And most important is that you are called to share, spread and be a witness of this love to others.

So, as today we celebrate the feast of the Trinity, let us pray that we do not forget who we are, our dignity of being the image of God, the "Trinity" God. And let us reflect this image of God, of love, of true relationship, of unity. Let us work to bring happiness and joy by being creative like the Father, compassionate like his Son, and dispose our talents in the service of others like the Holy Spirit...
