strength to endure their suffering and hardship.

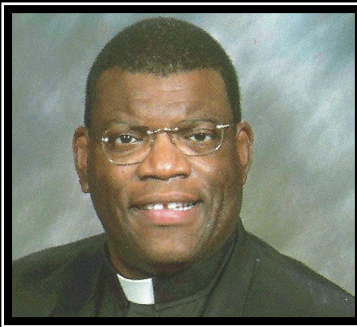
